Dear Parents

Junior School - last two weeks of Summer Term

I am writing to give further details concerning some of the special dates in our calendar during these last 2 weeks of term.

Please note that school finishes at 12 noon on Friday 10th July

Thursday 2nd July, 6 pm - Music for a Summer's Evening – Whole S chool
(Performance by children in J2 upwards)

It is not expected that many children involved will be staying to either crèche or prep on this evening, as parents will need to have time to feed them and return to school with them, washed and brushed and in uniform by 5.45 pm.

Creche and prep will be available for those who will need this, but children will need to be collected promptly so that staff can also get prepared for the evening.

Monday 6th July – Primary Choral Day – Choir J4-J6

We are hosting what we believe is the first ever Junior School Primary Choral Day, having invited pupils from several other junior schools in and around the city. During the day our Junior School choir pupils shall be rehearsing together in a range of different groups and will be performing at 4 pm. All parents are welcome to come along and join us then.

Tuesday 7th July, 2.30 pm – King's Magic Cloaks

(Performance by Lower Junior School - R, J1 and J2).

Parents are welcome to take their children home after the performance. Friends of Westbourne will be serving tea and biscuits. Crèche as usual.

Wednesday 8th July, 7 pm – Goldilocks and the Three Bears

(Performance by Upper Junior School - J3/J4/J5/J6).

Please note that children should be taken home at the end of the school day as usual, and returned by 6.15 pm in uniform. Crèche as usual. No prep.

Thursday 9th July, 5 – 6.15pm - Prize Giving for J2 – J6.

Crèche will operate as usual for R and J1 only, finishing at 5.45 pm. J2 – J6 children will stay at school. They will have a snack provided (or bring your own), a playtime and an opportunity to "wash and brush up". Parents may take children home if they wish, but should return them by 4.45 pm to the Lower Yard.

Parents of J2 – J6 may collect any R - J1 siblings from crèche **before** coming to the marquee and sit with them (perhaps on the knee) in the marquee if other arrangements cannot be made. Creche staff will need to leave on time.

J6 pupils and their parents will be invited to stay after the Prize Giving ceremony for a buffet and refreshments.

Prize winners who receive a cup should take the cup home and arrange to have their names engraved as appropriate. Cups should be returned to the Junior School office by half term next summer, engraved and polished.
